

Clubhouse Attire_

It is expected that Members will choose to dress in a fashion that benefits the surroundings and atmosphere provided in the Club setting. Specific dress requirements for varying dining times and events will be posted. It is also expected that members will advise their guest(s) of Club Attire requirements.

- As a courtesy, men must remove hats / caps in the Clubhouse.
- Shirts and Shoes are required inside the Clubhouse.
- Talking on cell phones is prohibited inside the Clubhouse.
- Business Casual attire is required for Thursday, Friday & Saturday evening dinners in the main dining area. (denim, t-shirts, shorts, sandals, or flip flops are <u>NOT</u> permitted in the main dining room for dinners or specific special events, dress code will be enforced).
- Resort Casual attire can be worn in the 19th hole bar area on dinner nights.
 (denim, appropriate tshirts, and shorts can be worn in the 19th hole bar area only. No flip flops are allowed).
- Jackets for gentlemen are at times required for specific special events or dinners and will be noted in advance.
- Swimsuits are <u>NOT</u> permitted in the Clubhouse, Swimsuit cover ups and shoes are required.

Golf Attire

- Dress code for golf applies to the putting green, driving range, practice areas, pro shop, and locker rooms as well as the golf course.
- Male golfers must wear appropriate golf attire, golf slacks. Bermuda shorts, shirts with collars, or non-collared shirts with sleeves. Mock turtlenecks are also acceptable. Shirts must be tucked in at all times. Cargo shorts are NOT permitted.
- Female golfers must wear appropriate golf attire, collared shirts, or non collared shirts with sleeves, golf slacks, Bermuda shorts, and golf skirts. Tank Tops & T Shirts are <u>NOT</u> permitted.

FITNESS CENTER RULES

Fitness Center Hours: 4:30 am – 10:00 pm

Use of the fitness center is for member(s)/guest(s) only. All minors (15 and under) **MUST** be accompanied by an adult at all times while in the fitness center.

UPDATE: For the consideration of other members and guests.
Cigarette/ Cigar Smoking and Vaping are not allowed inside the pool, pool area, or around the cabana. A designated smoking area has been established outside the gate at the pool entrance.

- NO lifeguard on duty, swim at your own risk.
- The Club is not responsible for any damage to Member's or Guest's personal property,
- <u>Swimming Attire</u>: All swimmers must wear swimming attire. <u>Cut-offs</u>, Shorts, and <u>Thongs are <u>NOT</u> allowed. Appropriate attire is required to enter the <u>Clubhouse</u> when coming in from the pool; <u>Cover-ups</u>, shirts, and shoes are required. We also ask that you be <u>dry</u> before entering the clubhouse.</u>
- · ALL Members must notify management of any guest(s) that may be using the pool under their membership.
- Any member/guest not having authorized access to the Club facilities will be asked to leave the facility.
- For the safety and cleanliness of the pool, cloth or disposable diapers are not allowed in the pool. Infants & toddlers who are not yet toilet trained <u>MUST</u> wear appropriate swimming diapers while in the pool. Please change your child only in the restroom facility.
- ALL children (12 and under) must be supervised at all times by a responsible person 18 years or older.
- NO outside food & beverages or coolers permitted when the clubhouse or cabana is open.
- NO GLASS of ANY TYPE is allowed in the pool or spa areas at any time; this includes after-hours when the clubhouse is closed.
- Toys: Frisbees, sports equipment, and small hard balls are not allowed. Recreational floats, body boards, water guns, nerf, and beach balls, are <u>NOT</u> permitted, for small children in need of swimming assistance, arm floats are allowed.
- Skateboards, bikes, rollerblades, etc., are <u>NOT</u> allowed inside the pool area.
- Pool furniture is <u>NOT</u> allowed in the pool. Please <u>DO NOT</u> move or remove umbrellas or bases surrounding the pool.
- Safety: Horseplay, running, piggyback rides, undue splashing, or other unsafe activities are not permitted.

 Jumping or Climbing over the pool fence enclosure is NOT permitted.
- Portable Music: Individual portable music must be used with headphones.
- Pets are **NOT** permitted in the pool area.
- Amelia National staff members have the authority to enforce pool rules & regulations at any time.
- Member(s) & Guest(s) privileges may be denied, withdrawn or revoked at any given time for reasons
 considered sufficient by Management.



Frequently Asked Questions

Who maintains the stormwater ponds?

 The CDD maintains stormwater ponds within the District.

Who maintains the pond banks?

 With the exception of the pond located at the entrance to the community, individual Lot Owners are required to maintain such grass, plantings or other lateral support to prevent erosion of stormwater pond banks (Pursuant to the HOA Dedarations).

Why do some ponds look bad?

- Pond bank erosion oucurs over time with drainage of surface water from land into the stormwater ponds.
- Please notify the District Office of concerns you have regarding the condition of the pond itself such as algae growth or aquatic vegetation within the pond.

Who maintains the common areas?

The common areas outside the gates are maintained by the CDD. However the amenity center, including the parking lot, pool with bath house, meeting area, training room, covered lanal, tot lot, and tennis court, are the responsibility of the HOA or Club.

Who should I ask for approval of my home improvement?

 The Architectural Review Committee of the HOA. The CDD has no authority over private property.

To which entity should I report a water or sewage or roadway related problems?






